IN THE CLASSROOM

Year 9 English recently completed a unit on Debating.

In teams of 3, students researched a topic and participated in a formal debate. Topics included raising the age of provisional drivers in Victoria, bringing back the death penalty, that animals should not be kept in zoos and that all children should participate in a sport. There was lively debates between the affirmative and negative teams and excellent attempts at rebuttal. All students in this class presented a speech and worked effectively in their teams. Their speeches were planned, written on cue cards and presented with confidence. Being able to speak in front of an audience can be a daunting task but is such an important skill for students to develop and practice. Well done to this class for showing Grit and Initiative.











STUDENT ACHIEVEMENTS

On Saturday, 16th of August our Year 10 student Nathaniel Kuchel completed his drag racing licence to compete in a senior class; at current this makes Nathaniel the youngest Victorian to currently have a licence to run with seniors.

He stepped out of running juniors at the end of March due to out growing his junior dragster but managed to finish 9th out of 68 racers that had competed in the National Drag Racing Championship over 10 rounds. With his best performance being runner up while racing in Perth at the beginning of March.

Nathaniel had never driven this vehicle before but he did a best time of 6.17 second in 200 meters at a speed of 113 MPH (181 kmph) as he does more runs he will lower this time to run roughly 5.5 seconds @ roughly 200 kmph!


Great work Nathaniel we can't wait to hear more about your drag race journey.

DOCTORS IN SCHOOLS


DiSS Clinic
