Exams and finishing off/starting new electives – this year we really believe that our students took their exams and tests seriously. They have been given the opportunity to catch up on exams due to illness. We are also congratulating our students who are attending the lunch time catch up sessions that the staff are organising. For parents you will see an event on your child's Compass that will show that they are expected to attend a catch up session – if you could continue to encourage their attendance that would be great. Our re-vamped Redemption Policy has proven to be very effective with students having a two week window to redeem a task with support from the lunchtime catch up sessions. If a student doesn't redeem their work they will get the original mark or if they didn't hand the work in it will result in a 0 for that piece of work. Having a fair and consistent approach with high expectations around learning is why we expect to see our students thrive academically.

This week we have started Semester 2 – this impacts our elective program and gives the electives a more balanced time allocation over the two semesters. This doesn't impact core subjects that run for the year.

<u>Reports</u> – The learning progression reports are being finalised now and will be uploaded to Compass on the last day of term. You will see that we have added an S and N to each subject as well as the usual progression point. The S an N will indicate that your student has/has not achieved an average of 50% or above for the semester. Again the study catch up sessions have been designed to give all students the opportunity to receive an S but it is totally up to the student to make the most of the opportunities that we provide at Irymple Secondary College.

<u>Staffing Update</u> – we welcome Rupa Oberoi to our Science team. Rupa is a very experienced Science teacher and will be a great asset to our team.


Have a great term break everyone, keep safe and warm. This will be my last newsletter for a while as I will be enjoying some sunshine and down time up North.

INTERSCHOOL 9/10 BOYS AFL


