After school: School grounds are supervised up until 3.50pm on school days (excluding the last day of each term, which is 2.50pm)

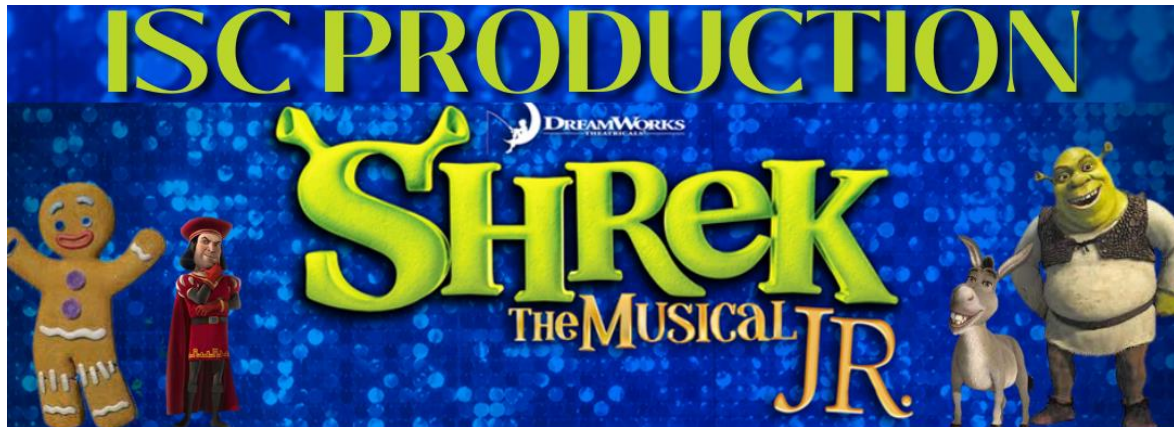
Students on school grounds outside these times will **not** be supervised (unless they are attending a before or after school care program or supervised extracurricular activity).

INTERSCHOOL BASKETBALL

On Thursday 31st August Junior Interschool Basketball was held at the Sporting Precinct.

ISC had a total of 4 Junior teams entered – Year 7 Girls / Year 7 Boys / Year 8 Girls / Year 8 Boys.

Our Year 7 Girls competed in the Year 8 division (Pool A) and came up against Henderson College, St Joseph's College, and Merbein P-10 8s, securing one win against Henderson. Our Year 7 team then went straight into the grand final against the only other Year 7 team (Merbein P-10 7s) and unfortunately lost.

Year 8 Girls came up against Trinity Lutheran College, Merbein P-10 7s and Chaffey Secondary College, snagging a win in all games. We then had a semi against Merbein and won, but then faced St Joseph's College in the grand final and had a close loss (16-20).

Thank you to parent helper, Taleah Dolic who coached BOTH girls' teams and did an amazing job.

The Year 7 Boys had two games on the day, winning both very comfortably. Against Merbein the scores were 26 to 12 and against Chaffey the scores were 32 to 8.

The Year 8 Boys had two pool games against Red Cliffs and Chaffey. They played really well and went through to the semi-finals undefeated. In the semi-final we came up against Trinity college. The game was very tight eventually going into double overtime and luckily Irymple came out on top.

The grand final was then against St Joes which wasn't as close, with Irymple winning 28 to 16.

On Thursday 7th of September, we sent 2 teams off (9/10 Girls and 9/10 Boys) to compete in the Interschool Intermediate Basketball competition also held at the Precinct.

Our 9/10 Girls won 2 and lost 1 taking them into the semi defeating Henderson by 7. Unfortunately, they didn't take out the win in the grand final against St Joseph's College (20-8) but they fought hard and gave it their best, it was a tough game played by all.

Our 9/10 Boys won two of their pool games comfortably beating Coomealla and Chaffey but lost to St Joes. In the semi-final Irymple played Merbein and beat them by 12. This meant the team came up against St Joes again, however the boys played really well, and their defence was a standout, eventually beating them by 14 points.

AROUND SCHOOL

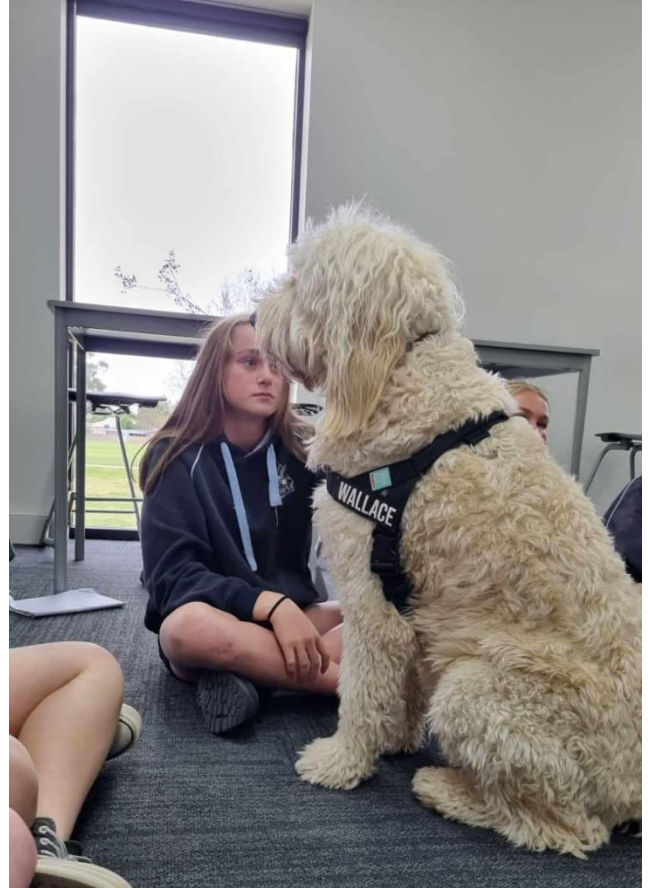


