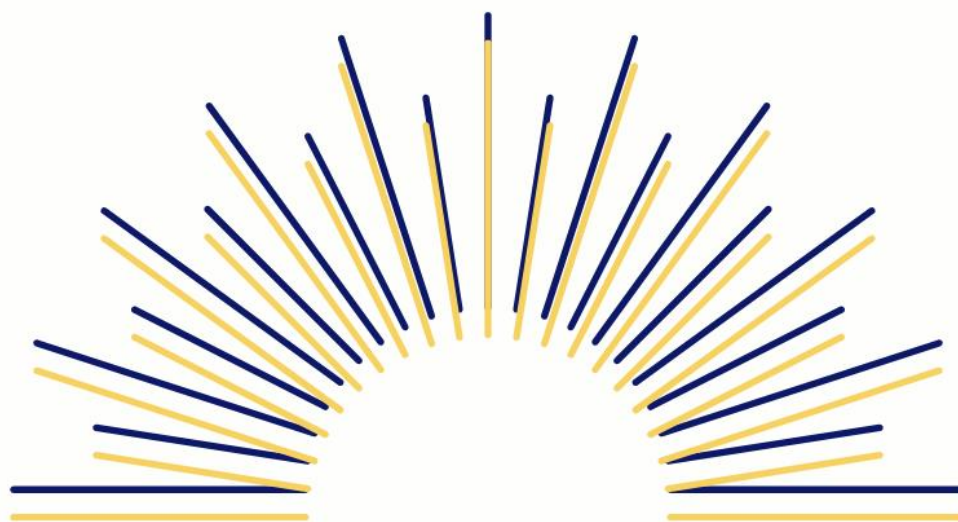

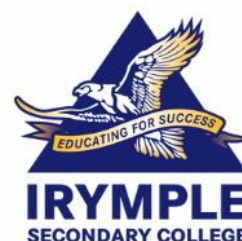

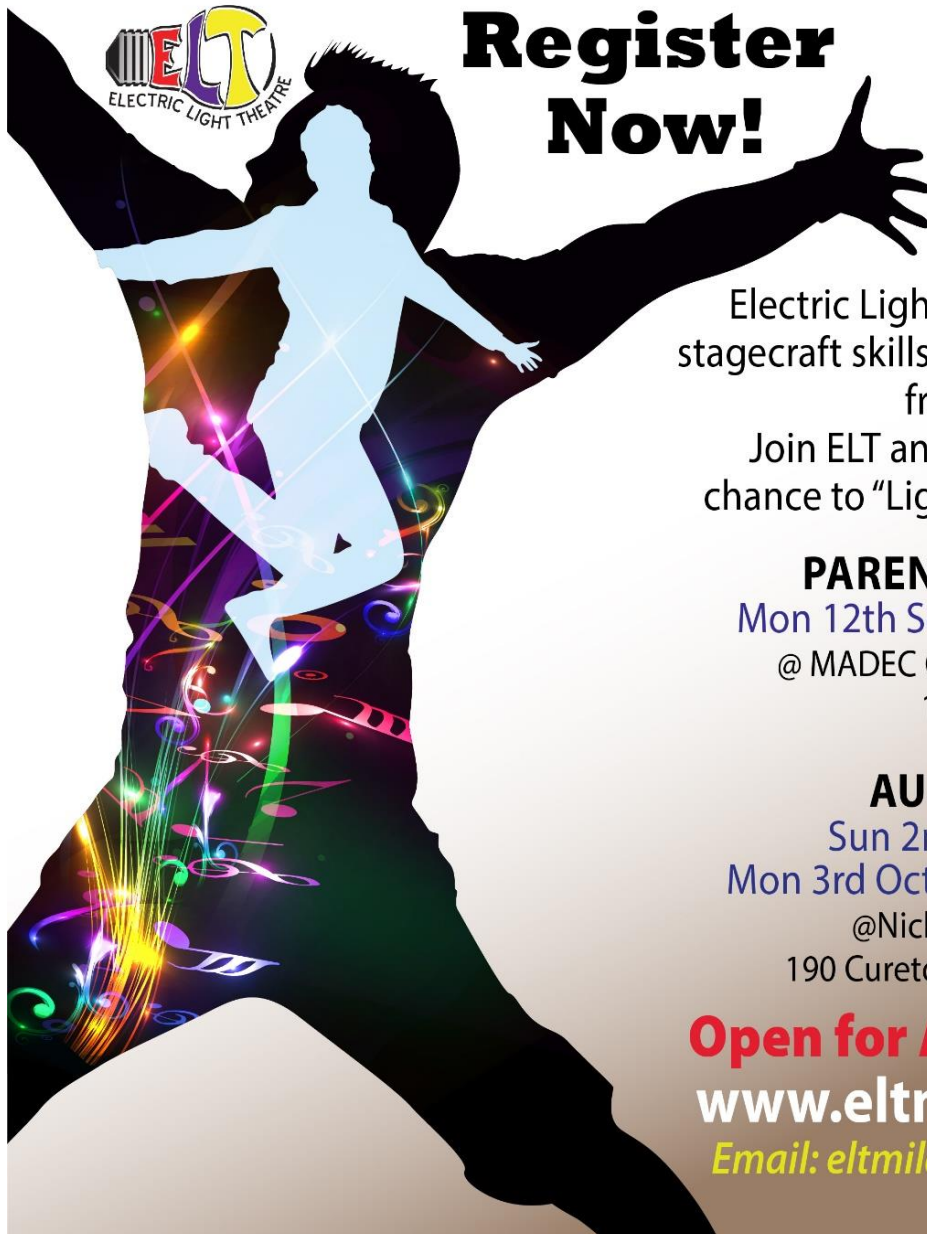


## ELECTRIC LIGHT THEATRE
